ZONE 16 OPEN PENNANTS 2023


The Zone has confirmed that Jamberoo will field both a Grade 5 and Grade 7 team for the up coming Pennant season.



Do this drill twice a week and be amazed at your improvement.

THE SEQUENCE

Bowl 4 up and 4 back to get a feel of the green. This is not a reliable test on strong windy days.

1. Place mat on the T, place jack on minimum mark. Bowl 2 on forehand and 2 on the back hand. Each bowl inside 60cms scores a point. Bowl 4 bowls back to the jack on the T, 2 on the forehand and 2 on the backhand, measure as before.


- 2. Place mat on the T, place jack on the medium mark, repeat as in 1.
- 3. Place mat on the T, place jack on the maximum mark, repeat as in 1.
