How the Magpie Cup is Played

I have had a few questions about the format of the Magpie Cup from folks who have yet to play one, so I will lay them out here:

- 1. The teams for the Ambrose are randomly selected, you **put** your name down between 1-1:30pm and the names for each team are drawn randomly. This means you get to meet new folks, and helps to even out the golfing level.
- There are no handicaps, it is what you get off the stick, but it is Ambrose, so you all take each shot and take the best.
 However you need to take 2 tee shots from each player during the round.
 - 3. It is 9 holes, not a full round.
- 4. The reason it is \$15 for Jamberoo Golf Club members, and \$30 for non-Jamberoo Golf Club members, is that everyone is paying \$15 which is donated to charity, but Jamberoo Golf Club members play for free, and non-members are paying \$15 for the round of golf (which is a discounted price from those good folks at the Golf Club).
- 5. There are **no prizes**, except Bragging Rights of course, it is just a real fun day, playing some golf, meeting some new people having a few drinks and raising some money for a good cause.
